



TICKETING INFORMATION

@Large: Ai Weiwei on Alcatraz

San Francisco • September 27, 2014—April 26, 2015

Tickets to the unprecedented exhibition on Alcatraz by Chinese artist and activist Ai Weiwei are now on sale. Individuals may purchase tickets up to three months in advance of when they plan to visit. Alcatraz tours operate seven days a week and tickets may be purchased online at www.alcatrazcruises.com. Visitors may also buy tickets in person at the Alcatraz Landing ticket office at Pier 33 on The Embarcadero, or by calling the Alcatraz Ticketing Center at 415-981-ROCK (415-981-7625).

Given Alcatraz's popularity, admission tickets typically sell out several weeks in advance, and as especially high demand is expected for the *@Large* exhibition, the public is encouraged to purchase tickets as early as possible. (As example, tickets for October 15, 2014 became available July 15, 2014; tickets for January 15, 2015 go on sale November 15, 2014, and so on.)

TICKETING OPTIONS

***@Large* exhibits are open at no additional charge to both individual and group purchasers.**

Ticket prices include admission to all Ai Weiwei installations, as well as the award-winning Alcatraz audio tour. Exhibition organizers recommend allocating 3 ½-to-4 hours on the island to experience both the *@Large: Ai Weiwei on Alcatraz* exhibition (min. 90 minutes) and the Alcatraz cellhouse, including the 45-minute audio tour (approx. 2 hours).

Adults & Juniors (12–61)	\$30
Child (5–11)	\$18.25
Seniors (62+)	\$28.25
Family Pass (2 adults + 2 children)	\$90.25
Children ages 4 and under	FREE

Group Admission:

Groups of 15 persons or more may reserve Alcatraz tickets now for the duration of *@Large: Ai Weiwei on Alcatraz*. Group ticket purchases may be made by e-mailing groups@alcatrazcruises.com or calling 415-438-8361.

Special @Large Night Tours:

Guided *@Large: Ai Weiwei on Alcatraz Night Tours* are offered Thursday—Monday evenings. Ferries for these exhibition Night Tours depart Pier 33 at 5:25 pm (30 minutes earlier than the normal Night Tour boat to give visitors more time on the island to experience *@Large*). Tours include an on-island orientation, escorted tour through all of the *@Large* exhibition areas (New Industries Building,



Hospital, A Block and the Dining Hall), and the opportunity to take the Alcatraz cellhouse audio tour or join a regular Night Tour in progress after viewing the Ai Weiwei installations.

@Large Night Tour ticket prices are \$37 for adults (18–61), \$36 for juniors (12–17), \$21.75 for children (5–11), and \$34.25 for seniors (62+). Alcatraz Night Tours are limited in capacity and typically sell out well in advance. Visitors may purchase tickets up to three months in advance at www.alcatrazcruises.com.

Special @Large Early Bird Exhibition Tickets & Tours (Limited Availability):

In anticipation of high demand for @Large: Ai Weiwei on Alcatraz tickets, a limited number of seats on the Early Bird boat (departing Pier 33 at 8:45 a.m. seven days a week) will be set aside each day to accommodate exhibition visitors. These Early Bird tickets and tours may be reserved by contacting the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy at 415-561-3021 or online at aiweiweialcatraz@parksconservancy.org. (NOTE: These reserved Early Bird tickets are not available through Alcatraz Cruises.)

- **Early Bird Exhibition Ticket:** \$50 per person for adults and juniors, \$38.25 for children (5–11), and \$48.25 for seniors (62+). These tours include:
 - Round-trip ferry service from Pier 33 to Alcatraz
 - Special orientation on the island
 - Exhibition-related commemorative gift
 - Regular Alcatraz admission and the cellhouse audio tour

- **Early Bird Exhibition Ticket with Guided Tour:** \$125 per person for adults and juniors, \$113.25 for children (5–11), and \$123.25 for seniors (62+). These tours include:
 - Round-trip ferry service from Pier 33 to Alcatraz
 - Special orientation on the island
 - Guided docent tour of the @Large exhibition
 - Copy of the @Large: Ai Weiwei on Alcatraz full-color exhibition catalog
 - Exhibition-related commemorative gift
 - Regular Alcatraz admission and the cellhouse audio tour
