## January 2018

**January 3 (Wednesday) – McCullough/Conzelman Road, Marin Headlands.** Today we'll hike and remove isolated weed infestations to protect the heart of important endangered Mission Blue Butterfly habitat! Fantastic progress has been achieved by HRT in the last 25 years! **Meet at the roundabout parking lot at the Conzelman Rd/McCullough Rd. intersection.** [Map Link](#)

**January 10 (Wednesday) - Fairfax-Bolinas Road, Bolinas Ridge.** Join HRT and One Tam as we transform a 5-acre French broom invasion into native grasslands! Your help is needed to plant natives! Wonderful oak woodlands and patches of prairie grace this slope with Bolinas lagoon views. **Meet on Fairfax-Bolinas Road pullout near Hwy-1.** [Map Link](#)

**January 17 (Wednesday) - Gerbode Valley, Marin Headlands.** Protect the amazing Marin Headlands! We'll be planting natives today and pulling French broom. **Meet at the parking lot in front of building T111 off Bunker Rd. in the Marin Headlands.** [Map Link](#)

**January 24 (Wednesday) - Coastal Trail and Conzelman Road, Marin Headlands.** Enjoy the spectacular vistas while roving with the team removing non-native trees and other invasive plants to protect habitat for the endangered Mission Blue Butterfly. **Meet at the pullout off of Conzelman Road near Hawk Hill.** [Map Link](#)

**January 30 (Wednesday) - Dipsea Knoll, Stinson Beach.** We will hike the lovely forested Dipsea Trail and remove invasive plants like Cape ivy, broom, veldt grass and English ivy. **Meet at the pullout by Dipsea Trailhead near Panoramic Hwy/Hwy-1 intersection.** [Map Link](#)

## February 2018

**February 7 (Wednesday) – Fairfax-Bolinas Road, Bolinas Lagoon and Ridge.** We'll leap frog to various sites to plant natives and pull small weed infestations as we continue to transform this wonderful habitat on the Pacific flyway with Bolinas Lagoon views. **Meet on Fairfax-Bolinas Road pullout near Hwy-1.** [Map Link](#)

**February 14 (Wednesday) – Homestead Valley, Mt. Tamalpais.** Join HRT and One Tam to see the earliest wildflowers among some of our finest coastal prairie. We will be pulling French broom and controlling veldt grass to protect this endangered prairie community! **Meet at the pullout by the fire road gate off of Panoramic Hwy.** [Map Link](#)

**February 21 (Wednesday) – Tam Fire Site, Tam Valley.** We're pulling French broom and removing sapling Eucalyptus trees to restore woodlands on this ridge. Come see the transformation made since 12 acres of Eucalyptus trees burned and were removed in 2004. **Meet at the Eastwood Park tennis courts.** [Map Link](#)

**February 28 (Wednesday) - Rodeo Valley, Marin Headlands.** We'll rove the rich coastal valley and bluffs of Wolf Ridge and remove small patches of Cape-ivy, ice plant, Thoroughwort, Jubata grass and other exotics. **Meet at the Coastal Trailhead near the Rodeo Beach parking lot.** [Map Link](#)

**March 7 (Wednesday) - Stinson Terrace, Bolinas Ridge.** We'll rove above the gulch looking for sparse broom, Helichrysum, and Thoroughwort to pull. Glorious vistas framed with panoramic sky and ocean views will inspire and rejuvenate us! **Meet at the end of Avenida Farralone at the Willow Camp fire road gate.** [Map Link](#)

**March 14 (Wednesday) - Homestead Valley, Mt. Tamalpais.** Join HRT and One Tam and don't miss the amazing wildflowers among some of our finest coastal grasslands! We will be pulling French broom and controlling veldt grass to protect this endangered prairie community! **Meet at the pullout by the fire road gate off of Panoramic Hwy.** [Map Link](#)

**March 21 (Wednesday) - McKennan Gulch, Bolinas Lagoon.** Join us to improve riparian habitat along Bolinas Lagoon. We'll also pull broom and Cape ivy as well in this lovely canyon north of Stinson Beach. **Meet at the pullout under the pine trees off of Hwy-1.** [Map Link](#)
