Here are examples of what your gifts are achieving in the Golden Gate National Parks:



\$1,000

Tuition, food, and “after-care” for a young person to participate in a two-week Crissy Field Center **summer camp**

A group of youth visiting the national parks for the first time through the “Parks to People” program



\$2,500

20 weed wrenches and tools used by volunteers to control French and Scotch broom at Marin Headlands sites

Waders and monitoring equipment for 15 volunteers studying the threatened red-legged frog

One month of youth programming, including the Counselor in Training program for high school students



\$5,000

Care and nurture of 1,500 plants at a **native plant nursery** for habitat restoration in the Presidio

Symposium to convene experts on control of invasive species in sensitive parklands

Scholarship support for one student to participate in Urban Trailblazers, a five-week environmental youth leadership program



\$10,000

One year of population monitoring of snowy egrets and black-crowned night herons on Alcatraz

A year of monitoring the endangered **mission blue butterfly** populations in San Mateo County

A year of support for an I-YEL (Inspiring Young Emerging Leaders) intern to develop leadership skills as he/she educates youth and the San Francisco community about ongoing environmental issues



\$25,000

Four months of public engagement, outreach, and education to support major projects like the revitalization of Lands End

Sponsorship of an entire **volunteer program**, and educational workshops for staff and volunteers
