January 2019

January 9 – Easkoot Creek, Stinson Beach. We're removing a new section of Cape-ivy with One Tam to maintain restored stream side Steelhead habitat today. Join the Planting Season Picnic! Bring something to share for the potluck. **Meet at Stinson Beach central parking lot.** [Map Link](#)

January 16- Fairfax-Bolinas, Bolinas Ridge. Plus One Tam! We'll be roving the ridge and controlling veldt grass and French broom invasions today! Wonderful oak woodlands and patches of prairie grace this slope with Bolinas lagoon views. **Meet on Fairfax Road pullout near Hwy 1.** [Map Link](#)

January 23- Rodeo Valley, Marin Headlands. We'll rove the rich coastal valley and bluffs of Wolf Ridge and remove small patches of Cape-ivy, ice plant, thoroughwort, jubata grass and other exotics. **Meet at the Coastal trailhead at Rodeo Beach.** [Map Link](#)

January 30- Dipsea Knoll, Stinson Beach. We will hike the lovely forested Dipsea trail and remove invasive plants like Cape-ivy, broom, veldt grass and English ivy. **Meet at Dipsea trailhead on Panoramic near Highway 1 just south of Stinson Beach.** [Map Link](#)

February 2019

February 6 – Coastal Trail and Conzelman Road, Marin Headlands. Enjoy the spectacular vistas while roving with the team removing non-native trees and other invasive plants to protect habitat for an endangered butterfly. **Meet at Hawk Hill on Conzelman Road.** [Map Link](#)

February 13 – Homestead Valley, Mt Tamalpais. Plus One Tam! See the earliest wildflowers among some of our finest coastal prairie. We will be pulling French broom and controlling veldt grass to protect this endangered prairie community! **Meet at on Panoramic Hwy at fire road gate by Cypress trees.** [Map Link](#)

February 20 – Gerbode Valley, Marin Headlands. We'll be planting natives today and pulling French broom. **Meet at T111 in Rodeo Valley.** [Map Link](#)

February 27 – McCullough-Conzelman Road- Today we'll hike and remove isolated weed infestations to protect the heart of important endangered Mission blue butterfly habitat! Fantastic progress has been achieved by HRT in the last 25 years! **Meet at Battery Spencer.** [Map Link](#)

March 6 – McKenna Gulch, Bolinas Lagoon. Join us to improve riparian habitat along the Pacific flyway. We'll remove Cape-ivy and pull broom as well in this lovely canyon north of Stinson Beach. **Meet at McKenna Gulch pullout.** [Map Link](#)

March 13 – Homestead Valley, Mt Tamalpais. Plus One Tam! Don't miss the amazing wildflowers among some of our finest coastal grasslands! We will be pulling broom and controlling veldt grass

to protect this endangered prairie community! **Meet on Panoramic Hwy at fire road gate by Cypress trees.** [Map Link](#)

March 20- Rodeo Ave to Alta trail, Marin Headlands. We'll caravan up the ridge and remove broom and jubata as we go to protect butterfly habitat! **Meet at the park gate on the west side of highway 101 at Rodeo Ave exit.** [Map Link](#)

March 27 - Rodeo Valley, Marin Headlands. Join us to hike this scenic trail, pull broom and cut small pines as we make our way around the summit of Hill 1111 to protect endangered Mission blue butterfly habitat! **Meet at Baker Barry tunnel parking lot (limited parking, call the office to arrange a carpool ride) or meet on the west side of hwy 101 at Spencer Ave exit.** [Map Link](#)
