January 2020

January 1 – No Program Today. Happy New Years!

January 8 – Fairfax-Bolinas, Bolinas Ridge. Your help is needed to plant natives and pull broom as we continue to transform this 5-acre French broom invasion. Wonderful oak woodlands and patches of prairie grace this slope with Bolinas Lagoon and migratory bird views. **Meet on Fairfax Road pullout near Hwy 1.** [Map Link](#)

January 15 – Rodeo Valley & Conzelman, Marin Headlands. Join us to hike this scenic region, we'll pull broom, cut small pines, and drop mulch as we make our way around the summits of various hills to protect endangered Mission blue butterfly habitat! **Meet at Conzelman Roundabout at intersection with McCullough Road.** [Map Link](#)

January 22 – Homestead Valley, Mount Tamalpais. We're planting native plants and pulling French broom and other weeds to protect exemplary prairie habitat today on this lovely ridge on Mount Tam's flank. **Meet at the pullout on Hwy 1 by the fire road gate and cypress trees.** [Map Link](#)

January 29 – McKennan Gulch, Bolinas Lagoon. Join us to improve riparian habitat along the Pacific flyway. We'll remove Cape-ivy and pull broom as well in this lovely canyon north of Stinson Beach. **Meet at McKennan Gulch pullout on Hwy 1.** [Map Link](#)

February 5 – Dipsea Knoll, Stinson Beach. We will hike the lovely forested Dipsea trail and remove invasive plants like Cape-ivy, broom, veldt grass and English ivy. **Meet at Dipsea trail pullout on Panoramic hwy & Route 1 just south of Stinson Beach.** [Map Link](#)

February 12 – Homestead Valley, Mount Tamalpais. Join us on this lovely ridge to pull broom to protect exemplary coastal prairie on Mount Tam's flank. **Meet at gate on Panoramic.** [Map Link](#)

February 19 – Kirby Cove Campground, Marin Headlands. Your Help will protect amazing Headlands habitat! We'll be mulching/planting today. **Meet at Kirby Cove gate on Conzelman at Battery Spencer.** [Map Link](#)

February 26 – Easkoot Creek, Stinson Beach. We're weeding to maintain restored stream side Steelhead habitat. **One Tam's joining** for Cape-ivy control work and see amazing native plantings at the new septic site. **Meet at Stinson Beach.** [Map Link](#)

March 4 – Battery Alexander/South Rodeo Beach Trail, Marin Headlands. We'll spread straw to ensure invasive plants can't take over this lovely point with ocean views. **Meet at Battery Alexander.** [Map Link](#)

March 11 – McKennan Gulch, Bolinas Lagoon. One Tam joining us to improve riparian habitat along the Pacific flyway. We'll remove Cape-ivy and pull broom as well in this lovely wetland and canyon north of Stinson Beach. **Meet at McKennan Gulch pullout on hwy 1.** [Map Link](#)

March 18 – Stinson Terrace, Stinson. We'll rove above the gulch looking for broom, Helichrysum, and spurge to pull. Glorious vistas framed with panoramic ocean views **Meet at Avenida Farrallones.** [Map Link](#)
