July 2019

July 3 (Wednesday) – Conzelman Paths and Kirby Cove Campground – We'll return to Slacker Ridge with Golden Gate views to pull and mulch priority weeds. Dense pines continue to cede to diverse Creekside grasslands! **Meet at Kirby Cove gate.** [Map Link](#)

July 10 (Wednesday) – Homestead Valley, Mount Tamalpais with One Tam! – Today ridge top rove will focus on removing invasive brooms from one of the finest coastal prairies in the park. Stunning views of the bay and ocean will reward us! **Meet at the ranch gate on the Panoramic Highway.** [Map Link](#)

July 17 (Wednesday) – McKennan Gulch, Bolinas Lagoon – Join us to improve riparian habitat along Bolinas Lagoon. We'll also pull broom and Cape-Ivy as well in this lovely canyon north of Stinson Beach. **Meet at McKennan Gulch on Highway 1.** [Map Link](#)
