October 2019

October 2 (Wednesday) – Point Bonita, Marin Headlands – We'll spread rice straw to ensure invasive plants can't take over this lovely point. Views of the Golden Gate channel will reward us. **Meet at Camp Bicentennial.** [Map Link](#)

October 9 (Wednesday) – Fairfax-Bolinas Rd., Bolinas Ridge. This is a joint **One Tam Day!** Join us to hike and control invasive plants on this majestic ridge overlooking Bolinas Lagoon. **Meet on Fairfax Rd at the pull out near Highway 1.** [Map Link](#)
